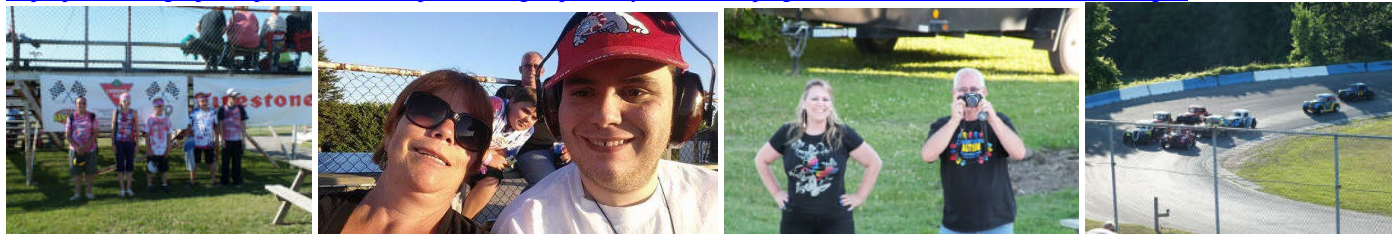

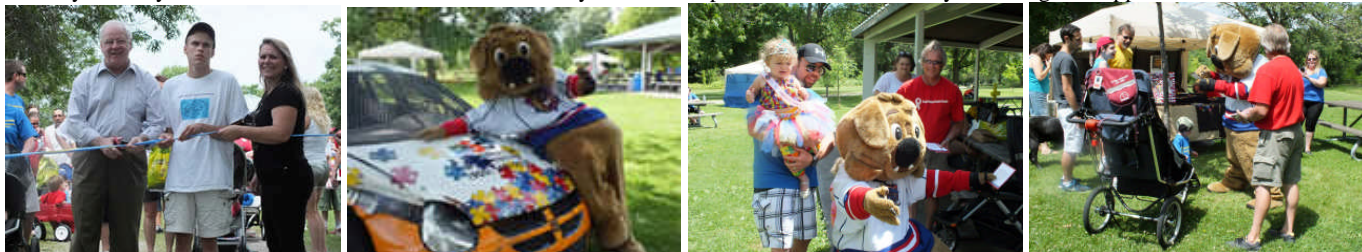
### **Sunset International Speedway July 12<sup>th</sup>** –
