2017 Allocations

- ~\$2,500.00: <u>Autism Service Dogs</u> -partially fund on-going educational predatory classes for parents and the children receiving the service dogs. Autism Service Dogs does Fostering the integration of children with autism by training, placing and supporting dogs that offer safety, companionship and independence.
- ~ \$3,000.00: Portia Learning Centre- (Ottawa)Research of Parent-mediated intervention for the behaviour and development of infants at risk for autism spectrum disorder which will be an ongoing research project. This study is being conducted in collaboration with Dr. Maurice Feldman at Brock University. Results to be presented at international conferences and Ontario Association for Behavior Analysis Annual Conference. The Portia Learning Centre offers a variety of Services for individuals of all ages. Our team Of Behaviour Analysts, Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Speech and Language Pathologists and Physiotherapists are here to help you and your family
- ~ \$7,855.65: Family Resource Association- (British Columbia)- This to accommodate 10 youth ages 12-18 of the ASD Spectrum for 2 week into the Summer Day Youth Adventure Camp. This is to help with socialization and have buddies, focus on social development, group cohesion and emotional regulation. Also to transfer these learning's back into the home. They are a team of professionals who are dedicated to helping children, youth and families in the communities we serve. Their services are offered at no cost and can be accessed through self-referral as well as by referral from government and community agencies.
