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
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Hello Everyone WE Are Open But with Restrictions Due to COVID19

- 1) Our office is now open but only by appointment. Coming into our office you must have a mask on. If not we will supply one to you as we have a table set up at our entrance with sanitizer, gloves and face masks on it. A mask MUST be worn in the office.
- 2) We would also like to let you know ALL of the foundations events as well as the ones that are being put on for us through the community and other sources as a fundraiser are **ALL POSTPONED** for now.

We did allocate out to the Halton Police in January for Badge Battle and the money going to Camp FACES which is for families of Emergency Services as it provides families who have suffered this tragic loss the opportunity to be with others who have experienced similar loss. Because many Emergency Services have children with autism we thought this would be perfect
